MASTER OF MUSIC (150 ECTS CREDITS)

Major subject: Instrument, a minimum of 100 ECTS credits

Instrument studies
Ensemble playing or chamber music
Orchestra, a minimum of 8 ECTS credits
Theoretical studies and research and writing skills, a minimum of 9 ECTS credits
Demonstration of proficiency (includes maturity essay) 20 ECTS credits

Optional studies, a minimum of 30 ECTS credits

If a student is studying in the 2.5-year master's programme without a Sibelius Academy bachelor's degree, the major subject studies must include a course in study planning.
