

**Dr Sami Alanne, DMus, MPhil** is an authorized music therapist, music psychotherapist, psychodynamic psychotherapist, and training psychotherapist in music psychotherapy. He has long clinical experience in music therapy, music psychotherapy, psychiatric rehabilitation, and health care of over 20 years. Alanne graduated as a music therapist from the Sibelius Academy (1999), Master of Philosophy (music therapy), University of Jyväskylä (2001), Doctor of Music, Sibelius Academy (2010), psychodynamic music psychotherapist, Extension School, University of Oulu (2011), and the training psychotherapist in music psychotherapy, University of Oulu, Faculty of Medicine (2013).



Dr Alanne is the founder of health care company Apollo Terapiapalvelut Ky (Apollo Therapy Services), which provides individual and group therapy, supervision, training, and consultation. In the field of music and health, the company has been a forerunner, participating and supporting its development, research, education, and practice internationally. It has collaborated with many universities, institutes, and professional education programs. Alanne has contributed to the training of educators, and social and health care professionals, in their basic, advanced, and continuing studies. Apollo Therapy Services produce psychotherapy and special advanced medical rehabilitation for Kela (Social Insurance Institute of Finland), and therapy services for the HUCH (Helsinki University Central Hospital) and HUS (The Hospital District of Helsinki and Uusimaa). Clients are children, adolescents, adults, and their families.

Dr Alanne is the author of the topical and groundbreaking books *Music Psychotherapy with Refugee Survivors of Torture* (2010) and *Musiikkipsykoterapia* (2014). Over the years he has published several professional and scientific writings and articles in academic journals. Alanne established and completed the first official health care music psychotherapy training in Finland. Recently, he has worked as the head and designer of the new music psychotherapist training curriculum, leading to the registered psychotherapist title and health care profession, at the University of Oulu.
