



How to fill in the online application form for the Sibelius Academy

GENERAL INFORMATION

*You can only fill in the application form once, so be sure to include all the study programmes you want to apply to. If you do not have a Finnish social security number and you fill in the application form more than once, **the most recent application will stay effective and the other ones will be removed.** Remember also, that you can apply only once using one e-mail address!*

- Go to www.studyinfo.fi
- See the right side of the page for “**Joint applications and application forms / January**” and choose “**Joint application to higher education spring 2018, Application period 1**”
- Choose “**Fill in application**”

PERSONAL DATA

Fill in your personal information as carefully as possible. Remember to fill in an e-mail address that you use actively! Sibelius Academy informs applicants on matters concerning applying and entrance examinations mainly via e-mail.

ELIGIBILITY

Fill in all the educations that you have completed, also those you complete after the application period but before 10 July 2018. If you graduate after the application period has ended, choose the alternative best applies to your forthcoming degree and mark 2018 as the year of completion or give an estimated graduation date if asked.

Uniarts Helsinki does not have a quota for first-time applicants in 2018.

STUDY PROGRAMME CHOICES

All Sibelius Academy’s programmes can be found under ‘**University of the Arts Helsinki**’.

”3 yr + 2.5 yr” education (180 cr + 150 cr) leads both to a Bachelor’s and a Master’s degrees. ”Master’s Admission [...] 2.5 yr” education (150 cr) leads only to a Master’s degree and only applicants who already have a Bachelor’s degree or equivalent can be considered eligible.

Answer all questions as carefully as possible. Please also notice that many programmes do not allow applicants to change their entrance examination programme after the application period has ended. N.B.! There are two application periods in the Joint application. You can apply to up to six study programmes in Joint application. Remember to plan all your applications already in January! During the second application period, you cannot remove chosen programmes from the first application period anymore!

KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERIENCE

Sibelius Academy does not require you to answer questions concerning for example grades and grade average.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

If you do not check the box “*My admission results may be published online*”, your name will not be published on the Uniarts Helsinki admissions website if you are admitted to study in Sibelius Academy. In this case you may enquire after your results via e-mail from Sibelius Academy’s Admissions Office.

L A S T L Y

After sending your application, a so-called ‘Secure link’ will be sent to the e-mail address you’ve given in your application. Through this link, you’ll be able to change your chosen study programmes (add or remove programmes, change their preference order and change your personal information). If you wish to view the whole application or make other changes (than mentioned above), you must sign in to My Studyinfo service.
