MOTHER:

Yes, everybody out there will be so jealous.

DAUGHTER:

2. PIGGY SPARKLE ALONE IN THE JACUZZI

PIGGY SPARKLE:

I'm a big - big - pig in a
sick - sick - world.

I get older every minute,

and I don't know what to do with myself.

and everywhere.

Outdoor is an ocean full of pirates and sharks
And my jacuzzi is a bloody bloodbath
full of piranhas!

I ain't gonna be a dog

PIGGY SPARKLE:
